

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC ACCEPTANCE LETTER 2025

Congratulations, your child _____ has been invited to join the instrumental music program on _____.

The program includes one half hour lesson per week and a band rehearsal. Lessons are in small groups on a rotating timetable during the school term to limit interruptions to other classes. Timetables are given to students, class teachers and displayed on the band room door.

The school supplies instruments for students in their first year of tuition. After one year it is highly recommended that parents supply their child with their own instrument (except for the bass clarinet, tenor saxophone, trombone, euphonium and tuba).

The school has a Resource & Loan Scheme, please refer to the Student Resource Forms in the pack for percussion, student owned instrument and school owned instrument.

Fees for Participation in the Program

Tuition is provided free of charge by the Department of Education. However, there are some fees payable to partially recover the direct costs to the school of providing this program.

Year 4 - 6 Band Students:

- \$20 Instrumental Music Levy (compulsory for ALL excluding percussion students)
- \$100 Instrument Hire Fee
- \$50 Percussion Student Fee
- \$20 Own Instrument

For your child to commence Instrumental Music lessons we require the signed Acceptance Form to be returned to the school office by Thursday 14th November as we have limited spaces.

It is important that each student purchases a Starter Pack – Accessories (see attached list) for each instrument for lessons.
