## English

Exploring Informative Texts

<u>Teaching and Learning:</u> Students view and listen to a range of texts to understand and compare the text structures and language features of imaginative and informative texts.

<u>Assessment:</u> Students create an informative text with a supporting image.

#### Maths

Unit 3

Over the course of Term 3, students will learn about and be assessed on the following concepts:

Using units of measurement - sequence familiar events in the order that they occur, sequence the days of the week, connect the days of the week to familiar events. Number and place value - compare quantities, make quantities equal, combine small collections, represent addition problems, identify the parts and whole of problems, break quantities into parts, share collections, identify equal parts of a whole. Patterns and algebra - identify, copy, continue and describe growing patterns. Data representation and interpretation - identify questions, answer yes/no questions, use data displays to answer simple questions.

#### Science

**Our Living World** 

**Teaching and Learning:** Students use their senses to observe the needs of living things, such as animals and plants.

Assessment: Students suggest how the environment affects other living things. They share their observations of the growth of a bean plant.

## Technology

Teaching and Learning:
Students explore the characteristics and properties of materials and components that are used to produce designed solutions.

Assessment: Students design and make a spinning toy for a small child that is fun and easy to use.

# Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS)

**My Family History** 

<u>Teaching and Learning:</u> Students identify important events in their own lives. They recognise how people know about the past and celebrate events that are important to them.

Assessment: Students explore important events celebrated in their lives, and identify how people and objects help them to remember.

Together

Teaching and Learning:
Students create and respond to music by singing and playing instruments to chants, songs, poetry and rhymes.

Assessment: Students compose, perform and respond to music using the stimulus of different texts.

## **Health & Physical Education**

PE - Catch That Bean

<u>Teaching and Learning:</u> Students develop the fundamental movement skills of two-handed catching and underarm throwing and explore dynamic balances with beanbags. They apply these skills to solve movement challenges.

<u>Assessment:</u> Students perform underarm throwing, two-handed catching and dynamic partner balances with a beanbag and solve movement challenges.

HEALTH – I am Safe

<u>Teaching and Learning:</u> Students identify actions and protective behaviours that keep them safe and healthy in situations where they may encounter medicines, poisons, water and fires.
