Achieve the following results:

- Camira SS mean score in Year 3 & 5 NAPLAN reading equals or betters QLD mean score.
- 100% of students have an individualised reading goal targeted to their needs.
- 95% of Camira students achieve at or above Metropolitan regional targets.
- 95% of parents are satisfied their child's learning needs are being met at Camira SS.
- A performance development and coaching culture is embedded and visible across the school.

Our initiatives include

- Embedding a systematic and consistent approach to the explicit teaching of reading
- Effectively planning to meet our students needs
- Using data to grow student performance
- Implementing high quality evidence-proven pedagogical framework
- Differentiating our teaching practice to improve student outcomes
- Building the capacity of our teaching team

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a Deputy Principal to provide leadership in the area of reading. (\$130 000)
- Employ 2.6 FTE specialist STEM teachers to provide teacher release time to deliver focused and intensive teaching in the area of reading. (\$200 000)
- Purchase of IT resources including 75 tablets to complement school resources to create optimal 21st century learning environments and improve literacy outcomes. (\$120 000)
- Fund teacher release for targeted PD in reading and coaching to build the capacity of our teachers. (\$50 000)
- Employ a Speech Language Pathologist for an additional day to target oral language development in Preparatory Year. (\$12 000)
- Employ Teacher Aides to continue to support literacy improvement. (\$23 791)
