- Engage students in developing an inquiry mindset and independence with thinking, to become effective problem solvers.

## Our initiatives include

- Embedding high impact and evidence validated pedagogies through all learning areas.
- Consistent teaching and learning that is rigorous, purposeful and targeted.
- High quality differentiated practices within classrooms that support all learners to be successful.
- Access to PD for all staff ensuring continued capability development in line with DoE and school strategic plan.
- High quality STEM programs to engage students through an inquiry mindset.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing 2.8 specialist teachers to provide excellence in STEM teaching and release classroom teachers to facilitate focussed intervention for the students in their class in English and Mathematics (\$215,892).
- Employing Teacher Aides to support intensive teaching of reading within all classrooms (118,000).
- Funding teacher release for targeted PD in Literacy, numeracy and coaching to build the capacity of our teachers (P2P & PXP) (\$14,400).
